## SOFEMA CONTRIBUTES TO MINUSCA'S DEPLOYMENT

**Levallois-Perret, 30th January 2015** - As part of its participation in the United Nations Multidimensional Integrated Stabilization Mission in the Central African Republic (MINUSCA), the Islamic Republic of Mauritania has sought SOFEMA's support for the supply of equipment and vehicles in the context of power projection. These elements will be assigned to an infantry company and a police squadron within the Central African theatre of operations.

Created on the 10<sup>th</sup> of April 2014 by a United Nations Security Council resolution, the MINUSCA's mission is to stabilize the situation in the main towns and to contribute to the restoration of state authority throughout the country.

Strong of its expertise in military equipment renovation and optimization, SOFEMA leverages the technical infrastructure of its logistics platform located in the Central African region. A complete fleet composed of more than a hundred vehicles, with logistical and support ressources, was renovated in compliance with UN standards to prepare these materials to the requirements of roads in the savannah, jungle and the Central African rainforest.
